RE: Consultation on proposed admission arrangements for Alvaston Moor Academy & Lees Brook Community School

The purpose of this document is to inform you that Archway Learning Trust is undertaking statutory consultation on proposed admission arrangements on Alvaston Moor Academy and Lees Brook Community School. As required by the Department for Education's School 2021 Admissions Code the consultation period must last for a minimum of 6 weeks between 1 October 2021 and 31 January 2022, in accordance copies of the full proposed arrangements will be published on the Academy's website for the duration of the consultation period.

Background

Alvaston Moor Academy and Lees Brook Community School became part of the Archway Learning Trust in February 2021 and the Trust wish to have a consistent approach to in-year admissions across the trust and provide a more efficient and effective service to prospective parents.

Proposed changes to the admissions arrangements:

The proposed changes to Alvaston Moor Academy

- 1) The in-year admission process is now directly to the Academy

The proposed changes to Lees Brooke Community School

- 1) The in-year admission process is now directly to the School
- 2) Removal of criterion for applications received late but before National Offer Day. The arrangements for late applications is now detailed in the 'Late Application' section to ensure the criteria is relevant for both secondary school admission and in-year admission.
